Hitching system

With the tilting and pivoting linkage, maneuvering the rake is smooth and effortless. It makes hitching the machine much easier and also improves its ground following ability, which translates into increased raking performance and quality.





Gearbox

The oil-filled gearbox of the rotor (models Z-350 to Z-440) is quiet, durable, and low-maintenance.

In models Z-440 and Z-470, the tine arm connecting rods are replaceable, which significantly simplifies the repair process as there is no need for labor-intensive disassembly of the entire gearbox.

Gearbox oil level can be quickly checked through the convenient inspection window (excluding Z-470).









Raking height adjustment

The adjustment mechanism located above the linkage enables smooth and stepless setting of rotor height.



Tines

Depending on the model, the tine arms have three or four pairs of durable spring-loaded tines. They feature an improved shape, which helps pick up the crop and move it into place on the windrow with greater precision.

In addition, the outmost spring-loaded tine is protected against being dropped and lost in case it gets damaged midwork.

Tine arm mounting

The tine arms are easily and quickly attached with two pins, starting from model Z-410.

The hay rake frame has holders for storing the tine arms, which means they are safely secured in place during transport.



Chassis

The tandem axle helps with even distribution of the machine's weight across the ground. This type of chassis is also perfect for accurate ground following. It comes as standard in Z series rakes (excluding Z-350).

When working in wet conditions, there is room for additional adjustment by changing the height of the chassis attachment point.



Swath curtain

The foldable swath curtain has several height and tilt settings, allowing you to adjust the width and shape of the windrow.
